



**SEX OFFENDER RESIDENCE BOARD MEETING

MINUTES

1. Call meeting to order

Manager Houseman called the meeting to order at 4:01 pm.

2. Roll call

Present: Board Member Council Representative Schultz, Police Chief Bump and Chairperson Manager Houseman. Also present: Captain Lindsey and Clerk/Treasurer/Finance Director Ebbert.

3. New Business

- a. Review and possible action relating to the **Sex Offender Residence Appeal Form** from Edward M. Meyer.*

Mr. Meyer was not present as of 4:02 pm.

Captain Lindsey presented the findings, noting the application had missing information. The location of Mr. Meyer's residency exemption falls within 1,500 feet of several properties, including schools, preschools and day cares. Mr. Meyer's status does not require his to register as sex offender however, he meets the Ordinance definition of Offender as a Delinquent and therefore is subject to the residential restrictions of the City Ordinance.

Mr. Meyer was not present as of 4:10 pm.

Chief Bump noted the application was incomplete, and the defender was not present at a mutually agreed-upon meeting date and time. It was also noted the efforts of Captain Lindsey to complete the background check due to the defender not providing all the information.

Chief Bump made a motion to deny the defender's request for exemption effective immediately. Motion seconded by Cm. Schultz.

4. Adjournment

Cm. Schultz moved to adjourn, seconded by Chief Bump. Meeting adjourned at 4:14 pm.
